1. RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TOWN SUPERVISOR TO EXECUTE AGREEMENT WITH ADIRONDACK LANDFILL SERVICES, LLC

WHEREAS New York State Department of Environmental Conservation Part 360 regulations require post closure monitoring of the Town of Long Lake landfill, and

WHEREAS Adirondack Landfill Services, LLC (ALS) has been satisfactorily providing this service for the Town of Long Lake since 2009, and

WHEREAS ALS is offering the same service to the Town and holding the 2009 cost for services, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the Town Board of the Town of Long Lake hereby authorizes the Town Supervisor to execute and agreement with ALS for calendar year 2014 to provide post closure monitoring in accordance with NYSDEC Part 360 regulations for \$1873.00 plus any additional services that might be required, said services provided with prior approval.

2. ANNUAL TOWN-WIDE SPRING CLEAN-UP

Motion to Approve the Annual Spring Clean-up according to the policy, dates and request form as follows:

SPRING CLEAN-UP will be held from May 5th through May 16th, 2014. The Town of Long Lake Service POLICY is as follows:

- A. The Town is not responsible for any damage to my property incidental to this request.
- B. All service requests are for trash or other such materials as may fit in a single pick-up truck load (ex. old mattresses, furniture, metal, appliances).
- C. The Town will **NOT** pick up leaves, lawn clippings or brush; bagged or otherwise.
- D. The removal of junk cars and/or boats is limited to two items.
- E. Town Employees are not required to gather or pile the requested materials.
- F. The Town Employee's only requirement is to pick up and remove the materials described (below) by the owner.
- G. All trash, etc, shall be assembled at the curb or driveway edge for convenient removal.
- H. Mandatory Recycling and Waste Disposal Rules Apply
