AGREEMENT TO SPEND TOWN HIGHWAY FUNDS

TOWN OF : Town of Long Lake

COUNTY OF: Hamilton

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 284 of the Highway Law, we agree that the moneys levied and collected for the repair and improvement of highways, and received from the state for the repair and improvement of highways, shall be expended as follows:

1. GENERAL REPAIRS. The sum of \$ 249,060.13 may be expended for general repairs upon 21.29 miles of town highways, including sluices, culverts and bridges having a span of less than five feet and boardwalks or the renewals thereof.
2. IMPROVEMENTS. The following sums shall be set aside to be expended for the improvement of town highways:
 - (a) On the road commencing at Jim Bird Lane and leading to end of lane, a distance of 300 Ft, there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 118,000.00

 - (b) On the road commencing at Tifani Lane and leading to end of lane, a distance of 600 Ft, there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 2800
Type chip sealing Width of traveled surface 18 Ft
Thickness 1 inch Subbase _____
 - (c) On the road commencing at Owls Head Lane and leading to end of lane, a distance of 1100 Ft, there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 4600
Type chip sealing Width of traveled surface 20 Ft
Thickness 1 inch Subbase _____

No moneys set aside for such improvements shall be expended, nor shall any work be undertaken on such improvements, until the County Superintendent approves the plans, specifications and estimates for such construction.

This agreement shall take effect when it is approved by the County Superintendent of Highways.

 - (f) On the road commencing at Old Steamboat- End of Pavement and leading to end of dirt road, a distance of 800 Ft, there shall be expended not over the sum of \$ 8,000
Type double seal Width of traveled surface 20 Ft
Thickness 2 inches Subbase _____
